SUBJECT: 1996 Domestic Violence State Aid Rates (DVSAR) for Domestic
Violence Residential Programs in New York State

The purpose of this letter is to advise you of the 1996 Domestic Violence State Aid Rates (DVSAR) for licensed Domestic Violence (DV) residential programs in New York State. The promulgated rates have been calculated using the approved Domestic Violence rate methodology. Local districts are required to pay these promulgated per diem rates to licensed Domestic Violence residential programs providing residential care to all eligible victims of domestic violence.

This year, the Domestic Violence Flat Rates will not include a program rate adjustment. Again this year, we are promulgating DVSAR's for a minority of programs that will contain per diem rate reductions to compensate for 1994 program surpluses resulting from receiving government revenue in excess of spending.

The 1996 DSS Domestic Violence rate methodology includes the following features:

- o The flat rates are based upon staffing requirements mandated by regulations and are intended to ensure fiscal stability of Domestic Violence residential programs.
- o Different rate levels have been established for Domestic Violence programs located in New York City and the rest of State, based upon the costs of providing services.

- o Flat rates are also based on program type/size: Domestic Violence Programs/Shelters with bed capacity of 20 or less, Domestic Violence Programs/Shelters with bed capacity of 21 or more, Domestic Violence Safe Dwellings, and Domestic Violence Safe Homes.
- o No rate adjustment increase will be allowed for any program which wishes to exceed the flat rate designated for a particular type of residential program in a specific geographical area. DV rate consultations will only be allowed if the promulgated state aid rate is not at the maximum flat rate level or the food add-on was inadvertently omitted.
- o New or expanding Domestic Violence residential programs will be allowed funding for start-up expenses if the resident county approves those expenditures. A start-up rate will be calculated and added to the program's DVSAR.
- o We will continue to grandfather in the per diem rates established by local districts prior to the establishment of the Department's rate methodology which are higher than the applicable DV Flat Rate. However, those per diem rates will not be given rate adjustment increases in 1996. Affected programs will continue to receive either the grandfathered in rate or the Flat Rate, whichever is higher, as the basis for determination of the 1996 DVSAR unless program surpluses occurred in the base year.
- o The Food add-on rate is to be negotiated between the host county and the residential program in the first instance. The Department will revise the DVSAR to include the food add-on when we have been formally notified in writing. Thereafter, the food add-on will be included until otherwise notified. Notification to the Department can be made by either the program (with documentation from the local district) or directly by the local district.
- o The Department will continue the DVSAR rate policy of reducing future year per diem rates by the amount equal to the program's government revenue surplus calculated as a per diem amount in the base year.

Attachment B represents the official promulgation of the 1996 Domestic Violence residential programs' mandated state aid rates in New York State.
